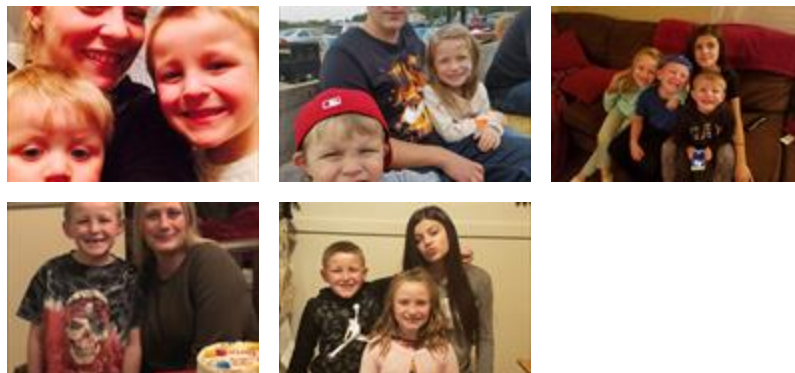

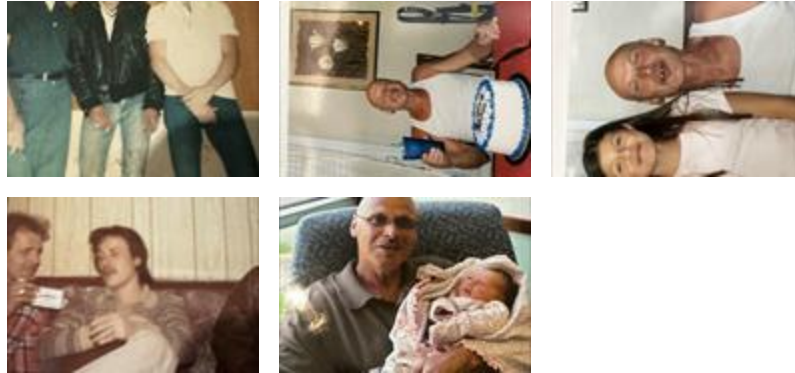
There's so many things I could say about Jeff because I adored him so much. I am so grateful for Jeff for he has taught me so so much he was a wise man.

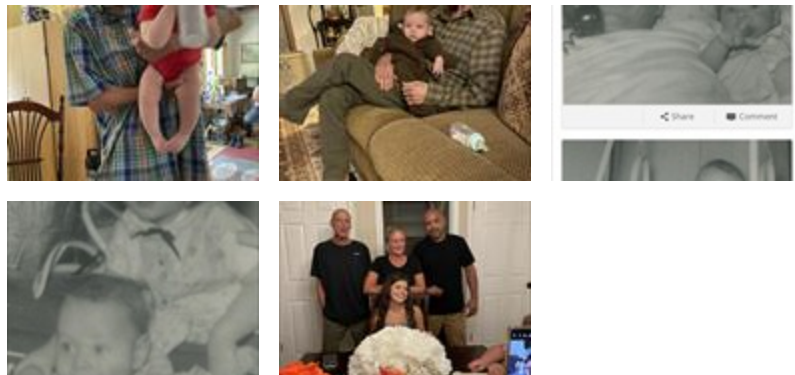
