John "Jack" Robert Kennedy, lost his brave fight with cancer on January 23, 2022. Jack was born June 12, 1945 to John F. and Alice M. (Burdick) Kennedy in West Allis, Wisconsin. He attended Beloit schools and graduated from Beloit Memorial High in 1963. Jack was a carpet rep for most of his career. Later in life, he joined Marling Lumber Co. for several years.
