Ralph Alba, age 90, of Beloit, WI, died on Sunday, November 1, 2020, at Azura Memory Care. Ralph was born on August 27, 1930, in Caledonia, IL, the son of Refugio and Soledad (Reyes) Alba. He grew up in Beloit, WI, and graduated from Beloit High School. Ralph worked at Fairbanks Morse in Beloit after high school, and later retired from there. He loved this country and was proud to be a United States Army veteran. He served during the Korean War, bravely fighting in the infantry on the front lines, and earned many medals by doing so.
