Ramona Elizabeth Weldon (Hundley), Mona, aka “The Blonde Bomber” of Beloit, WI passed away January 28, 2021 at Beloit Memorial Hospital due to complications of COVID 19. Ramona was a professional wrestler from 1946-1955 and is listed in the Professional Wrestler’s Hall of Fame in Jacksonville Beach, FL. She was previously employed at Regal Beloit, Freeman’s and Durst, and she retired from Blackhawk Technical College in 1994. Her hobbies included playing Yahtzee, bingo, Euchre, and spending time with family and friends.
