



## Robert Kluding

February 18, 1957 - May 10, 2025

Robert (Bob) Kluding passed away May 10, 2025, at his home in Wisconsin, Bob was 68.

He is remembered as very kind and loving and as a born-again Packer fan, although he still rooted for the Lions. Bob was the 6th child (the baby) of Paul and Patricia born in Connecticut on February 18, 1957, he was much loved. Bob had amyloids on his heart, kidneys, bladder and in his bones. On April 14, 2025, Bob fell and broke his humerus and just couldn't pull through this time.

He is survived by his loving children, Jim and Joe, his sister Kathi (Bruce), and besides his dear niece Traci (Mike), many other nieces and nephews.
